<p>Suspended</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lead a team to complete suspended scaffold works, including bosuns chair and swinging stage using proprietary needles and brackets.</li> <li>Does not include bespoke scaffold structures to support suspended scaffolds.</li> </ul>	<p><u>Suspended Certificate</u></p> <p>A. Boatswains chair – hand held or mechanical  B. Swinging stage – hand held or mechanical</p>
<p>Advanced</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Design, erect, alter, dismantle and inspect multi-faceted and complex scaffolding. (Cantilevers, hung scaffolds, loading platforms and gantries, cantilevered loading platforms, advanced falsework)</li> <li>Provide site-wide leadership for scaffolding, including the supervision of staff on medium to large projects.</li> </ul>	<p><u>Advanced Certificate</u></p> <p>D. Bracket scaffolding for tank and formwork  E. Cantilevered scaffolding  H. Hung scaffolding – including chain and wire rope  I. Loading platforms cantilevered from scaffolding  K. National Certificate or NZ Certificate scaffolding qualifications are pre-requisite for attaining Certificates of Competence. The qualifications are achieved consecutively, i.e., elementary is achieved before intermediate which is achieved before advanced.

Suspended scaffolding may be achieved as a stand-alone qualification. Suspended is also a pre-requisite of the advanced qualification.
